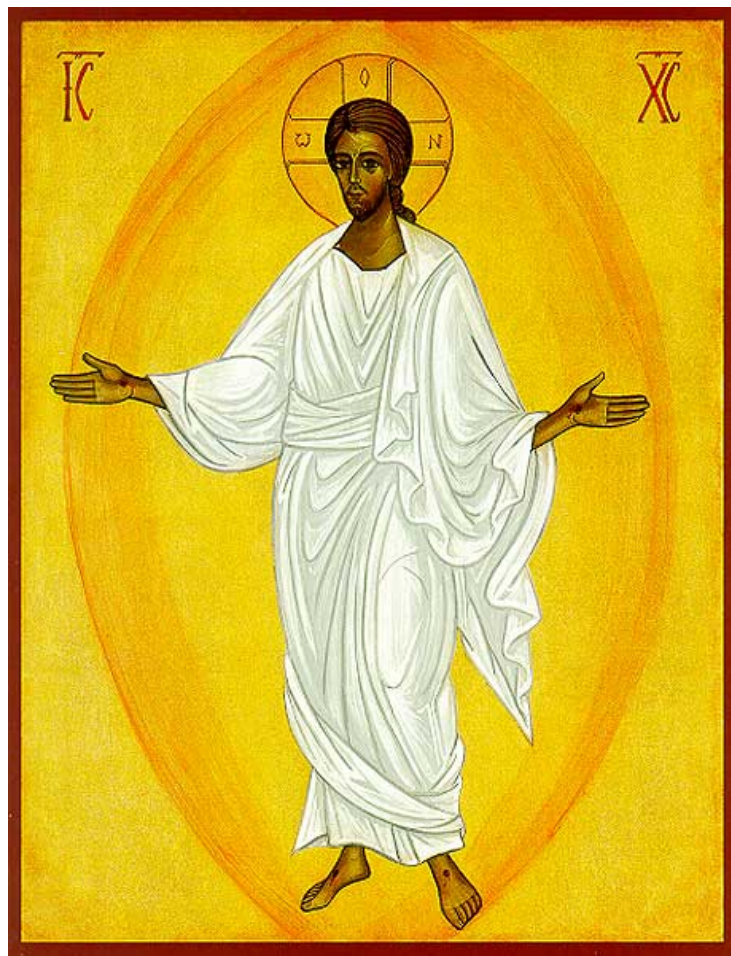

THE GATHERING

Please STAND as the President enters. The President greets the people:

My brothers and sisters,
we gather for worship in the name of ☩ the Father,
and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.
Amen.

The Lord be with you.
And with thy spirit.

Alleluia, Christ is risen!
He is risen indeed! Alleluia!

The President introduces the Prayers of Penitence in either of these words:

Christ our Passover lamb has been sacrificed for us.
Let us therefore rejoice by putting away all malice and evil and
confessing our sins with a sincere and true heart.

or

Christ died to sin once for all, and now he lives to God.
Let us renew our resolve to have done with all that is evil and
confess our sins in penitence and faith.

The President pronounces the Absolution:

Amen.

In silence, we pray.

Silent prayer; then the President prays the Collect.

At the end, all reply:

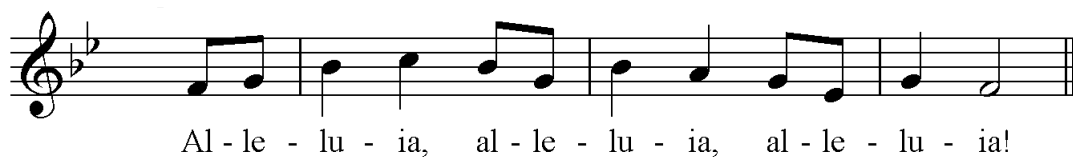
Amen

THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

Please SIT for a reading from the Old or New Testament follows. At the end:

For the word of the Lord.
Thanks be to God.

A Responsorial Psalm may follow; after which, please STAND for the Gospel, which is heralded by an Acclamation:



A cantor sings the verse and then the Alleluia is repeated:



The Lord be with you.
And with thy spirit.

Hear to the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Saint N
✠ Glory be to thee, O Lord.

At the end

This is the Gospel of the Lord.
Praise to thee, O Christ.

The President leads the Prayers of intercession, for which please sit or kneel:

In joy and hope, let us pray to the Father.

The following response may be used between each bidding:

Lord, in thy mercy
hear our prayer.

or

Lord, hear us.
Lord, graciously hear us.

or

Jesus, Lord of life
in your mercy, hear us.

At the end

We gather up these and all of our prayers in the company of Blessed Mary, *NN* and all the saints;
Merciful Father,
**accept these prayers for the sake of thy Son,
our risen Saviour Jesus Christ.
Amen.**

Please STAND as the President introduces the Peace:

THE LITURGY OF THE SACRAMENT

The risen Christ came and stood among his disciples and said, 'Peace be with you.' Then were they glad when they saw the Lord. Alleluia.

or:

The two disciples told what had happened on the road to Emmaus, and how Jesus had been made known to them in the breaking of the bread. Alleluia. The peace of the risen Lord be always with you. Alleluia.

and with thy spirit. Alleluia.

The altar is prepared and then the president takes the bread and the cup:

Risen Lord Jesus Christ,
we believe you, and all we have heard is true.
When you break bread may we recognize you
as the fire that burns within us,
that we may bring light to your world.
Amen.

The Lord be with you
and with thy spirit.

Lift up your hearts.
We lift them up unto the Lord.

Let us give thanks unto the Lord our God.
It is meet and right so to do.

The President continues the prayer, thanking God for all his saving works, and then invites the people to join their praises with the whole company of heaven:

..... for ever praising you and saying:

**Holy, holy, holy, Lord God of hosts,
heaven and earth are full of thy glory.
Glory be to thee, O Lord most high.
✠ Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord.
Hosanna in the highest.**

The President continues the prayer, repeating the Lord's own words over the bread and wine and asks the Father to send the Spirit on them to sanctify them.

Then:

**Great is the mystery of faith:
Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again.**

The President continues, joining our offering with Christ's sacrifice of himself. At the end:

**Through Christ, and with Christ, and in Christ,
in the unity of the Holy Spirit,
all honour and glory are yours,
O loving Father, for ever and ever.
Amen.**

Silent Prayer

Rejoicing in the power of the Resurrection, as our Saviour taught us,
so we pray:

**Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name, thy
kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give
us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses as we
forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into
temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom,
the power and the glory, for ever and ever. Amen.**

The President breaks the consecrated bread:

Jesus says, I am the bread of life, whoever eats this bread will live for ever.

Lord, our hearts hunger for you; give us this bread always.

We say Agnus Dei:

Jesus Lamb of God, have mercy on us.

Jesus, bearer of our sins, have mercy on us.

Jesus, redeemer of the world, grant us peace.

The president invites all to receive Holy Communion:

Alleluia. Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us.

Therefore let us keep the feast. Alleluia

Baptised persons who are communicant members of Churches which subscribe to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity, and who are in good standing in their own church, may receive Holy Communion at this service.

All taking part online are encouraged to make their Spiritual Communion, using the following prayer:

Lord Jesus Christ,
grant, that as the hem of your garment,
touched in faith, healed the woman
who could not touch your body,
so the soul of your servant
may be healed by faith in you,
whom I cannot now sacramentally receive;
through your tender mercy,
who lives and reigns with the Father
in the unity of the Holy Spirit ever one God,
world without end. Amen.

The President prays the Post Communion prayer, then:

THE DISMISSAL

The Lord be with you.
And with thy Spirit.

Alleluia. Christ is risen.
He is risen indeed. Alleluia.

The God of peace,
who brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus,
that great shepherd of the sheep,
make you perfect in every good work to do his will;
and the blessing of God almighty,
✠ the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit,
be among you and remain with you this Eastertide and always.
Amen.

or

God the Father,
by whose glory Christ was raised from the dead,
strengthen you to walk with him in his risen life;
and the blessing of God almighty,
✠ the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit,
be among you and remain with you this Eastertide and always.
Amen.

With the power that raised Jesus from the dead at work within
you, go in the peace of Christ. Alleluia, alleluia.
Thanks be to God. Alleluia, alleluia.
