Please do keep in your prayers all those who are preparing for Ordination as Deacon or Priest in the coming weeks, especially Daniel Burton, Helga Zunde-Baker, Francesca Perlman and Jordan McDermott, all to be Ordained as Deacon this time.

<u>Daniel</u> will be ordained alongside <u>Helga</u> and <u>Francesca</u> on 26 June in the Cathedral, and we'll welcome and install him as Assistant Curate the following day, 27 June - there will be a Parish Mass at 10am that day. He is currently moving into St Barnabas' Vicarage

It was announced this last week that <u>Francesca</u> will serve. her title with Fr Nicholas Peacock and the folk in Cheam Team Parish. Daniel, Helga and Francesca will all be Ordained in the Cathedral; it won't be open for the public to attend, but it will be live streamed and details will be passed on once we have them.

### **Morning Prayer**

Mattins (Morning Prayer) is celebrated each day, Tuesday-Friday at 0830. If you would like to attend, please let the Rector know beforehand; it is no longer live streamed.

### Compline

Compline (Night Prayer) is live streamed on our Fcebook Group at 9pm daily and the Common Worship Daily Prayer app is normally used (traditional language).

#### Low Mass

During the week, Mass is celebrated at 10am on Tuesdays, Wednesdays (Common Worship) and Thursdays (BCP). All are quiet, simple celebrations lasting about 20-30 minutes and are available to attend again and continue to streamed.
