### Morning Prayer & Compline

Morning Prayer is live streamed at 8.30am Tuesday - Friday and you'd be very welcome to join in; we use the *Common Worship Daily Prayer* app (contemporary language).

Compline (Night Prayer) live streamed is at 9pm daily; again, Common Worship Daily Prayer app is normally used (traditional language).

#### Low Mass

During the week, Mass is celebrated at 10am on Tuesdays, Wednesdays (*Common Worship*) and Thursdays (*BCP*). All are quiet, simple celebrations lasting about 20-30 minutes and will continue to streamed.
