Re-opening of church - further update

Next Sunday, we'll 'fling wide the gates', as we gather together for public worship for the first time since early March - for which we give huge thanks to God!

However.....under the new revised restrictions, we are limited to the numbers attending; we are, therefore, operating a booking in system. If you would like to attend the 10am Mass or a midweek Mass, please do either email or ring Marion Williams in the Church Office - **this will need to be done each time you plan on attending, please.** Orders of service will continue to be available online and we do encourage you to download them onto a phone or tablet and bring that with you. There will be a small number of single use paper copies available.

For a little while, the Sunday pattern of worship will be as it is now - 10am and 9pm. Please also note that:

- there will not be a collection at the Offertory; however, both contactless devices and collection boxes will be available near the doors. Please do put any offering in as you arrive;
- there will be NO congregational singing or post Mass refreshments;
- social distancing will need to be maintained;
- Holy Communion will be in one kind (bread) only;
- we are being discouraged from using altar rails as they tend to be touched by communicants, so the nave altar will be used on Sundays.

We will continue to live stream all services for those unable to attend.

Spread the word!

Like many churches, we've seen a huge increase in interest online since lockdown, with large numbers taking part in the online daily services, and the number of members of our Facebook group has shot up since it was launched in November. Morning Prayer, Mass and Compline (Night Prayer) continued to be streamed by the Rector and others. Please do encourage others to try us out - either via Facebook, or by subscribing to our (even newer) YouTube channel.

Similarly, if you register with www.easyfundraising.org.uk, there are a large number of shops and other businesses which will make a donation to All Saints' every time you purchase, again at no cost to you.

DAILY WORSHIP

Morning Prayer & Compline

Morning Prayer is presently live streamed at 8.30am Monday - Saturday (but do check the Noticesheet or Facebook first) and you'd be very welcome to join in. The *Common Worship Daily Prayer* app is used (contemporary language).

The beautiful office of Compline (Night Prayer) live streamed is at 9pm daily; again, *Common Worship Daily Prayer* app is normally used (traditional language).

Low Mass

During the week, Mass is celebrated at 10am on Tuesdays, Wednesdays (*Common Worship*) and Thursdays (*BCP*). All are quiet, simple celebrations lasting about 30 minutes and are streamed from Church.

These services, along with the Sunday Mass, Compline and The Bridge are also all available to watch on FaceBook and YouTube shortly after streaming.
