Fundraising

Sunday Club

Prior to lockdown, 'The Bridge' between the All Age and High Masses was a huge success, and we hope to restart it in some way.

However, it and the All Age Mass do not necessarily cater for school age children who are at least in top infants, if not a bit older. With that in mind, plans are under way to start a Sunday School/Club for this age group in September; it will meet in the Lady Chapel during the 1030 High Mass, for the first part of the service (just as happens in many other places), rejoining the service in time for Communion. It's likely that we'll use the same material as for 'The Bridge', aimed at a different age group.
