## Financial matters....

Through the Diocese, the PCC has signed up to an organisation called the Parish Giving Scheme, as a means of making our cashflow more efficient. Donations are made by Direct Debit to PGS and we do encourage you to sign up (if you give by Standing Order, it will mean cancelling it and setting up a Direct Debit to PGS). Each month, PGS will pay the All Saints' the full amount of donations they receive for us **plus** the Gift Aid due on those donations, which is how it will improve our monthly cashflow. ***This is particularly important at the moment, when our cash collections have been down and other income streams on hold.***

If, outside lockdown, you normally donate to All Saints' by weekly envelopes or the contactless devices, please do consider moving to donate via the PGS Direct Debit. Unlike direct debits for things such as utility companies, ***the amount is controlled by the donor (you)*** and not the church or PGS and you are of course protected by the Direct Debit Guarantee. ## Morning Prayer & Compline

Compline (Night Prayer) live streamed is at 9pm daily; again, *Common Worship Daily Prayer* app is normally used (traditional language).

During the week, Mass is celebrated at 10am on Tuesdays, Wednesdays (*Common Worship*) and Thursdays (*BCP*). All are quiet, simple celebrations lasting about 20-30 minutes and will continue to be streamed.

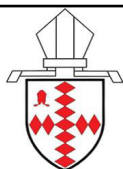
