Last Sunday, we were asked to carefully and prayerfully consider our regular giving to the life of All Saints'. Thank you to those who do give regularly - either weekly or monthly. If you haven't reviewed your regular giving for a while, we do encourage you to do so over the coming days and weeks. However, if you worship here regularly and haven't yet set up a form of regular giving, we encourage you to do either of the following:

The **PARISH GIVING SCHEME** (www.parishgiving.org.uk). We have signed up for this scheme and a good number of folk have already joined; thank you. The PCC receives a lump sum payment each month, including any Gift Aid claimed for the month, which helps hugely with our monthly cash flow. The staff at PGS are very helpful with setting it up - you are able to set the amount for each month and, if a UK taxpayer, **sign up for Gift Aid**, which is claimed for us by them each month,

or

STANDING ORDER, which can set up through www.carshaltonallsaints.org.

Either of the above helps to reduce our admin in banking cash, increases our cash flow and makes giving more efficient. Giving to the life of All Saints' on a regular basis allows us to plan for the future to continue to build God's Kingdom in this place.
