Saints this week.....



Laurence, deacon at Rome, has his day tomorrow, 10 August. One of the seven deacons in Rome associated with Pope Sixtus II, Laurence was martyred just before him. His interegators insisted that Laurence produce the treasures of the Church, which he duly did, assembling the poor of Rome with the words "These are the treasures of the Church". A later addition to the story is the manner of his martyrdom, being put to death on a gridiron. He died on this day in 258.



Clare was born in 1193 to a wealthy family in Assisi and as a young woman, heard St Francis preach. She subsequently ran away from home, first to the Benedictines, before chosing a more contemplative way of life and founded her own community and Clare was the first woman to write a religious Rule for women. It closely followed that of St Francis with members living in corporate poverty and relying totally on God; as a result, the community became known as the Poor Clares. In the years after Francis' death, Clare supported his followers in their desire to remain faithful to his vision, as she did. Clare died on this day in 1253.

Morning Prayer & Compline

Morning Prayer is presently live streamed at 8.30am Tuesday - Friday (but do check the Noticesheet or Facebook first) and you'd be very welcome to join in; we use the *Common Worship Daily Prayer* app (contemporary language). If you would like to attend, you'd be very welcome, but please let the Rector know first.

The beautiful office of Compline (Night Prayer) live streamed is at 9pm daily; again, Common Worship Daily Prayer app is normally used (traditional language).

Low Mass

During the week, Mass is celebrated at 10am on Tuesdays, Wednesdays (Common Worship) and Thursdays (BCP). All are quiet, simple celebrations lasting about 30 minutes and will continue to streamed; for now, we're asking that folk under the age of 70 avoid attending the Thursday Mass if possible please.
