We're now in the 10 days of prayer for the gift of the Holy Spirit on the Church today - something which was started a few years ago for the Church of England by Archbishops Justin and Sentamu and is now a global initiative across most denominations. Pentecost Sunday

Next Sunday is the end of the Great Fifty Days of Easter, when we remember the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the infant church and pray that the church in our own day, across the world and in different cultures and traditions will receive thesame gift once again. At the end of the Mass next week, we will each be 'recommissioned' to take the Gospel out into our communities; please have a lit candle to hand as you watch the Mass, symbolising our taking out the light of Christ into the world.

Please note that there will not be a Mass on Tuesday this week.

Re-opening of church

Since the streaming of services from church buildings has been allowed again, the Church of England has been regularly reviewing the advice offered to Cathedrals and Parish Churches.

The House of Bishops outlined three stages to re-opening church buildings; we are presently at Stage I, with daily prayer being offered and streamed from church. Stage 2 will see the buildings being opened to the public for private prayer, with strict hygiene and social distancing measures in place. The timing of this will be decided by the Government but won't be before 4 July. Stage 3 will be when some form of worship, open to the public, will be available - again, with strict hygiene and social distancing measures in place.

Morning Prayer & Compline

Morning Prayer is presently live streamed at 8.30am Monday - Saturday (but do check the Noticesheet or Facebook first) and you'd be very welcome to join in. The *Common Worship Daily Prayer* app is used (contemporary language).

The beautiful office of Compline (Night Prayer) live streamed is at 9pm daily; again, Common Worship Daily Prayer app is used (traditional language).

Low Mass

During the week, Mass is celebrated at 10am on Tuesdays, Wednesdays (Common Worship) and Thursdays (BCP). All are quiet, simple celebrations lasting about 30 minutes and are streamed from Church.

These services, along with the Sunday Mass, Compline and The Bridge are also all available to watch on FaceBook and YouTube shortly after streaming.
